- To improve teacher confidence in teaching different areas of the curriculum;
- To improve the resources available for curricular and extra-curricular activities.

Teachers are becoming more confident when delivering specialist area of PE – gymnastics 67% to 100% and dance 50% to 100% and in differentiating their lessons – 83% to 100% (all statistics taken from staff questionnaires). Teachers can use these skills in the next academic year as the staff profile has remained the same.
