

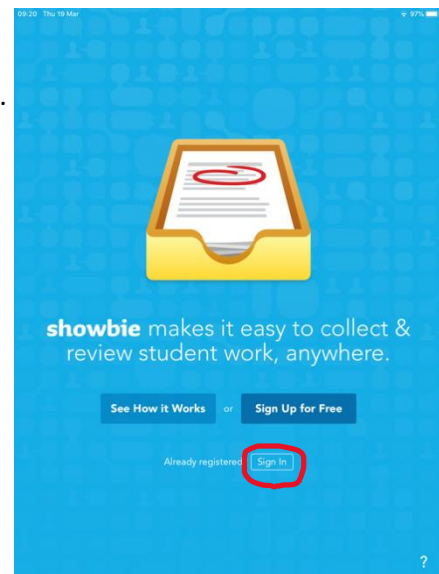
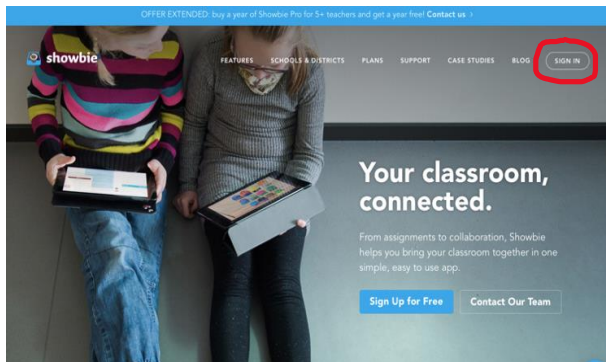

Showbie

Your child can access their lessons through the Showbie website (www.showbie.com) or app (available on the Apple App Store) as they do each day in school. Below are the steps to take to access their English, Maths and Guided Reading lessons.

1. Please select the **'Sign in'** option (indicated by the red circle on images below) rather than the 'Sign up for free' option.
2. Select your child's year group.
3. Select the English, Maths or Guided Reading folder.
4. Select the English, Maths or Guided Reading assignment.
5. Select Shared Items.
6. Select the appropriate lesson.



Please contact your child's class teacher if your child cannot log on to the Showbie website or app.

Oak National Academy

Pupils will complete their foundation subjects, like Computing, Science, History and Geography, through the Oak National Academy website. Teachers will paste a link to the lesson that they wish your child to complete that day into the Remote Learning folder on Showbie. Please click on the link and then work through the lesson on the Oak National Academy website. The lesson will include an interactive video to watch and then an end of lesson quiz to check pupils' understanding.
