	b. English: Daily English lessons will be provided. The lessons will cover Spring term objectives.		The English and Maths lessons will be uploaded to Showbie by 9.00am each day to mirror their school timetable.
	c. Reading: Web based comprehension activities will be provided. Guided Reading tasks will be provided.		Your child will need to access <a href="http://www.readtheory.org">www.readtheory.org</a> or <a href="https://en.fictionexpress.com">https://en.fictionexpress.com</a> (please email your class teacher if you have forgotten your child's log in details) to complete their reading task.
	d. Wider Curriculum: Pupils will be directed to daily Computing, Science, History and Geography lessons on the Oak National Academy website.		Your child will access their Guided Reading task through the Showbie website or app as they do each day in school. Wider Curriculum website links for specific lessons will be accessed through the Remote Learning folder on Showbie.
<b>What will your child be given to do each day?</b>	a. Maths: Your child will have access to a Maths lesson each day. b. English: Your child will have access to an English lesson each day. c. Reading: Your child will have access to a Guided Reading task each day. Your child will have access to comprehension questions on the Read Theory or Fiction Express website. d. Wider Curriculum: Your child will have access to one foundation subject lesson each day from the Oak National Academy.		
<b>How do children evidence work?</b>	a & b. In the lessons provided there will be slides, within the Showbie lesson, for pupil responses, for example after each task in English and Maths. Children will not need to download the lessons; they will be able to annotate onto the lessons using the tools available on Showbie. This will save their work automatically after pressing done when finishing the lesson. If there any technical issues and it is not possible to complete the work online, pupils are able to complete their work on paper and then post a photograph of the work onto Showbie. c. In the Guided Reading Task, pupils can answer the questions using the annotation tool on Showbie – just like their Maths and English lessons. d. Pupils can complete work on the Oak National Academy website or on paper if they wish.	<b>How will staff 'mark' work?</b>	a & b. Teachers will be able to see the completed lessons online on the Showbie website/app. Pupils are also encouraged to self-assess the work they have completed by using the 'Answer Clouds'. Where possible, please ensure that Maths and English lessons are completed by 1.00pm so teachers have time to feedback. We appreciate your understanding in advance if there is a delay in this. We will do our best to give pupils regular feedback. c. Pupils can mark their own answers, using the 'Answer Cloud' as they would in class. d. Pupils will complete the post lesson quiz on the Oak National Academy website.
